The Town of Weddington approved a resolution in 2017 to fund 11% of the final construction cost or an amount not to exceed \$143,000.00 to improve the Weddington Matthews Road and Tilley Morris Road intersection. Because of this endeavor, the Town, in conjunction with NCDOT, was able to obtain \$760,000 in STBG-DA funds to construct a roundabout. After many delays and unforeseen obstacles, NCDOT has completed ROW acquisition and is now working on utility relocation for this project. While working through this process, NCDOT has updated cost estimates to verify that funds needed to complete this project are in hand. The potential issues include that the current construction estimate for the project is \$2,442,000. There is currently \$1,852,230 in federal funds, which requires a 20% match (\$463,057.50) to authorize. Between the state dollars held (\$295,000) and the local match provided by the town (\$95,000) the match only equals \$385,000. This leaves \$78,057 short of what is needed to authorize the full federal amount. The last time additional state dollars were disbursed, (total is \$522,500 for PE, ROW and CON matches) NCDOT was told the amount would not be increased again. NCDOT is asking if the Town is willing to provide the shortfall of \$78,057 so NCDOT can authorize the full federal amount for construction. This does still leave the totals short based on the current estimate, but NCDOT is looking at having around \$100,000 left in PE that can be moved to construction. With an amended agreement between the Town and NCDOT, they plan to advertise in April, let in May, and construction start in June.

Complaint involving an "overgrown property". - Conducted several site visits. Property not in violation of ordinance.

2. 8308 Potters Rd. - (Utility building in front yard area without a permit)

Site visit was conducted and confirmed that construction is in progress. Issued a letter requesting the owner obtain a permit and take the appropriate actions to comply with setback requirements. Met owners and owners' representatives on site. Owner informed me that the "storage" building was "existing" when he purchased the property and he decided to enclose the storage building and install HVAC unit. The owner said his contractor failed to obtain the permit. I informed him the structure was in violation of Town Zoning ordinances (accessory buildings not allowed in front yard areas).
