## Update from the Planning/Zoning Office...

#### SUBDIVISON NEWS

#### Carringdon - Preliminary Plat

Carringdon is a proposed 71 lot conservation subdivision located at the intersection of Weddington-Matthews Road and Hemby/Beulah Church Roads.

The Town Council approved the preliminary plat at the Sept. 12 meeting.

#### The Enclave at Weddington - Final Plat

The Enclave is a 42 lot conservation subdivision located on Antioch Church Road. The developer will preserve the existing ponds on the property, as well as large sections of hardwood forest. The Council approved the final plat on Oct. 10 along with their entry monument and construction documents.

#### Weddington Pond -Preliminary Plat (formerly Sugar Magnolia)

Weddington Pond is an 18 lot conservation subdivision located on Hwy 84. The Town Council will review the preliminary plat at their November meeting.

#### CONDITIONAL REZONINGS

#### Threshold Church

In September the Town Council approved a conditional zoning (CZ) major amendment for Threshold Church located on Antioch Church Rd. Phase I was approved in 2014 and included parking and a new driveway. Phase II includes a 17,000 square foot building expansion, additional parking, and storm water management facilities. The Town Council approved their construction documents at the Oct. 10 meeting.

#### A Word From Our Tax Collector

Weddington property taxes are due on September 1 of every year and payable without penalty until January 5 of the following year. Property owners whose payments are postmarked on or after January 6 will be assessed a penalty of 2 percent interest for the month of January and an additional ¾ percent every month thereafter until the bill is paid.

The town tax rate for FY2016 is \$0.052 per \$100 assessed valuation. The Town does not send tax notices to taxpayers whose taxes are paid through their escrow account. If you pay your taxes directly and did not receive a tax notice, please contact the Tax Collector.

Deputy Jackson Hunt

#### Welcome our newest Deputy to Weddington!

Deputy Hunt has been with the Union County Sheriff's Office since 2013. He has worked in the jail, worked as a Contract Deputy with Indian Trail and a Patrol Deputy for the County.

Jackson served in the Marine Corps before moving to this area in 2012.

#### Stop Signs and Stop Lights

The Deputies want to remind the Weddington residents about stopping at Stop Signs and Stop Lights. Though this may not sound like something very serious, IT IS. Coming to a complete stop is the Law and is to ensure the citizens' safety, not only in our community but in the State.

North Carolina General Statutes 20-158

- (a) (1). At intersections, by erecting or installing stop signs requiring vehicles to come to a complete stop at the entrance to that portion of the intersection designated as the main traveled or through highway. Stop signs may also be erected at three or more entrances to an intersection.
- (b) (2) When a traffic signal is emitting a steady red circular light controlling traffic approaching an intersection, an approaching vehicle facing the red light shall come to a stop and shall not enter the intersection. After coming to a complete stop and unless prohibited by an appropriate sign, that approaching vehicle may make a right turn.
- (c) (1) When a stop sign has been erected or installed at a place other than an intersection, it shall be unlawful for the driver of any vehicle to fail to stop in obedience thereto and yield the right-of-way to pedestrians and other vehicles.

Please note, even if you are turning right at a stop sign or red traffic light, you must come to a complete stop before proceeding into the intersection.

Please obey the Law and let's' keep the citizens of Weddington safe.
