

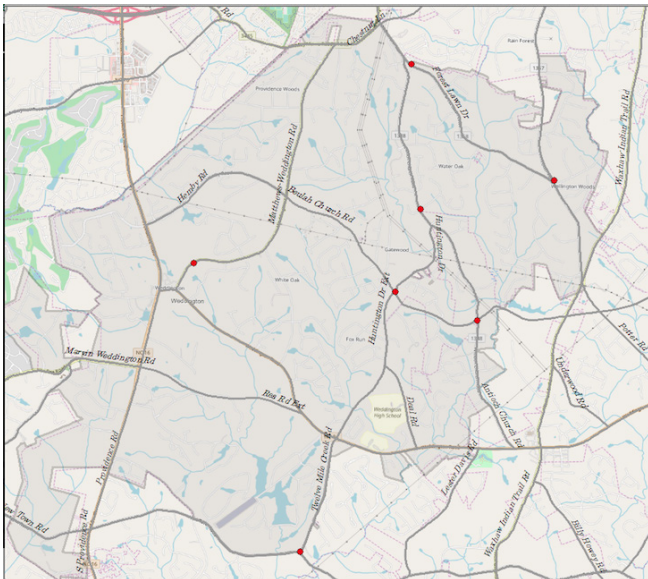

Weddington Level of Service Analysis

The Weddington Town Council authorized staff to enter a contract to perform a Level of Service (LOS) Analysis for certain intersections within Weddington. LOS is used to analyze intersections by categorizing traffic flow and assigning quality levels of traffic based on performance measures such as vehicle speed, density, congestion, etc.

The Town will see how each intersection is operating and model growth rates to predict when they will operate at a failing level of service. This will allow the Town to prioritize projects, plan, and budget for the local



matching funds over a number of years. The Town can be proactive and apply for grant funding versus waiting on the state to bring projects forward.

February 2019 Weddington Town Council Meeting Recaps

On Saturday, February 9th, the Weddington Town Council met for their annual retreat. Some of the topics of discussion included:

- The Weddington community survey,
- Changes to the conservation subdivision regulations,
- Level of Service Analysis,
- Rea Road Ext. widening project.

The Council also discussed the vision for the town plaza and park, town litter problem, and started preliminary budgetary discussions for fiscal year 2020. They set several goals for the upcoming year.

At the February 11th Town Council Meeting, the council renewed the urban archery season for 2020. They called for a public hearing for a conditional zoning amendment for Christ Lutheran Church at Rea and Reid Dairy Roads to be held on March 11, 2019. The council approved an erosion and sediment control ordinance and approved a definition for Community Recreation Center. They also started reviewing changes to the town Lighting Ordinance.
